## **COMPONENT I : WRITTEN SUBMISSION**

### **MAXIMUM MARKS - 10**

1. Students are required to prepare separate written submissions for each subject on the topic allotted to them by the Faculty In-charge of the subject.
2. **The topic allotted to the student shall be final.**

### **Guidelines for Written Submission**

1. The Written Submission must be **handwritten** in **English**.
2. The written submission shall consist of a **maximum of 5 pages / sheets written on both sides of ruled A4 Size Paper**. Additional two sheets shall be used for Title page and Bibliography respectively.
3. Writing references / bibliography is compulsory.
4. The pages should be numbered appropriately.
5. The Cover Page shall contain the following details:
  - a. Name of the student
  - b. Title of Submission
  - c. Subject
  - d. Roll number & Division
  - e. College Name
  - f. Name of the faculty to whom the project is being submitted
6. The pages should be numbered appropriately.
7. Students are required to submit the written submission to the faculty at the time of the Presentation.

## **COMPONENT 2: PRESENTATION**

### **MAXIMUM MARKS – 15**

1. Students shall be required to give a Presentation on their project topics.
2. The Viva-Voce for each subject will be held in the first week of October, 2024.
